**CURA** is a community based, non-profit organization dedicated to the treatment and rehabilitation of adolescences addicted to drugs and/or alcohol. Our bi-lingual staff specializes in treating a broad multicultural population. CURA Adolescent population is composed of young males, 13 to 18 years of age, with a history of substance abuse.

These residents live and participate in a large “family-like” environment where they contribute to its operation and upkeep. They learn the meaning of responsibility, personal hygiene, punctuality, honesty, and concern for others. Academic education is stressed because this is an area vital to ultimate success. We integrate an accredited academic curriculum with the comprehensive therapeutic components.

A large array of therapeutic and support services is provided to these young men as an integral part of the rehabilitation process.

- A complete physical examination upon admission
- Testing for HIV infection and education on HIV prevention
- Special services if they have AIDS or are infected with HIV
- Individual and family counseling

- Family meetings
- Group counseling
- Group education about alcohol and drugs
- Introduction to Alcoholic Anonymous (AA) and Narcotics Anonymous (NA)
- Recreational activities
- Educational and vocational development
- Aftercare planning

### ***Educational Program***

The Education Department is committed to providing its students with their educational needs. The Education Department is adequately equipped with the resources necessary to provide the following:

- Prepare for the GED exam (if 16 years old and with parental permission)
- Prepare to learn a trade
- Earn grammar school or high school credits
- Learn life skills
- Engage in extracurricular activities (i.e., visit museums, theaters and other cultural sites, sports events)
- Collaboration with all department staff to encourage academic progress and good behavior.
- Furthermore, for students to accept and internalize the values presented and get into active participation in our educational setting, they must feel a strong allegiance to the CURA’s Family Community
